



An EYFS musician will:

<p>In EYFS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses. • Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody. • Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.
<p>Perform This concept involves understanding that music is created to be performed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know twenty nursery rhymes off by heart. • To enjoy moving to music by dancing, marching, being animals or Pop stars • To sing along with a pre-recorded song and add actions.
<p>Compose This concept involves appreciating that music is created through a process which has a number of techniques</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Invent a pattern using one pitched note, keep the pulse throughout with a single note and begin to create simple 2-note patterns to accompany the song
<p>Appraise/Describe Music This concept involves appreciating the features of musical elements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know the stories of some of the nursery rhymes. • To learn that music can touch your feelings. • Explore high and low using voices and sounds of characters in the songs. Listen to high-pitched and low-pitched sounds on a glockenspiel.
