<p>In Key Stage 1</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will use their voice expressively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes • Play tunes and untuned instruments musically • Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of High quality live and recorded music • Make and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music
<p>Perform This concept involves understanding that music is created to be performed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take part in singing accurately following the melody • Make and control long and short sounds, using voice and instruments
<p>Compose This concept involves appreciating that music is created through a process which has a number of techniques</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clap Rhythms • Choose sounds to create effects • Create short musical patterns
<p>Transcribe This concept involves understanding that compositions need to be understood by others and that there are techniques and a language for communicating them</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance
<p>Appraise/Describe Music This concept involves appreciating the features of musical elements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify the beat of a tune
