

## A Year 2 musician will:

In Key Stage 1	<ul> <li>Children will use their voice expressively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes</li> <li>Play tunes and untuned instruments musically</li> <li>Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of High quality live and recorded music</li> <li>Make and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music</li> </ul>
Perform This concept involves understanding that music is created to be performed	<ul> <li>Follow instructions on how and when to sing or play an instrument</li> <li>Imitate changes in pitch</li> </ul>
Compose This concept involves appreciating that music is created through a process which has a number of techniques	<ul> <li>Create a sequence of long and short sounds</li> <li>Create a mixture of different sounds (long and short, loud and quiet, high and low)</li> <li>Sequence sounds to create an overall effect</li> <li>Create Short Rhythmic Phrases</li> </ul>
Transcribe This concept involves understanding that compositions need to be understood by others and that there are techniques and a language for communicating them	Use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance
Appraise/Describe Music This concept involves appreciating the features of musical elements	Recognise changes in timbre, dynamics and pitch
