<p>In Key Stage 1</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will use their voice expressively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes • Play tunes and untuned instruments musically • Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of High quality live and recorded music • Make and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music
<p>Perform This concept involves understanding that music is created to be performed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow instructions on how and when to sing or play an instrument • Imitate changes in pitch
<p>Compose This concept involves appreciating that music is created through a process which has a number of techniques</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a sequence of long and short sounds • Create a mixture of different sounds (long and short, loud and quiet, high and low) • Sequence sounds to create an overall effect • Create Short Rhythmic Phrases
<p>Transcribe This concept involves understanding that compositions need to be understood by others and that there are techniques and a language for communicating them</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance
<p>Appraise/Describe Music This concept involves appreciating the features of musical elements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognise changes in timbre, dynamics and pitch
